#### Location

Royal Palm Lawn, City Botanic Gardens. Corner Edward and Alice Streets.

#### Start zone

A marshalling zone for each coloured wave category is on Alice Street. Join the group that matches your race bib colour for the race start.

#### Your race number and times

Your race number is in your race kit. Ensure your race number is visible and placed on your chest throughout the event.

Runners and joggers will have a timing tag attached to the back of their race bibs. Walkers are not timed and do not have a tag.

Do not bend or remove your timing tag as this may affect your result.

Your timing tag is disposable and does not need to be handed in at the end of the race.

Runners and joggers, you will have your race time sent to you by SMS within 30 minutes of the race.

Timing results are also available on Sunday afternoon at **womensdayfunrun.com.au**.

### Getting to the event

#### Public transport

Participants receive **FREE** public transport on all Queensland Rail trains and Brisbane Transport buses on event day until 3 pm. Plan your trip using Translink's Journey Planner. Please note: Ferries and City Cats are not included.

#### Car parking

Participants can access special rates at Secure Parking and South Bank Parking on event day. Parks must be pre-booked using promotion codes.


