

Terms and Conditions – Participant Registration for Smiddy Challenge New Zealand 2027

Entry into Smiddy Challenge New Zealand 2027 with Mater Foundation's "Mater Uncancer Smiddy" program is deemed to be an acceptance of Terms and Conditions of Entry.

- A.** Mater Foundation Ltd operating as Mater Foundation (ABN 96 723 184 640) 14 Stratton Street, Newstead 4006 ("**Mater Foundation**") is a registered Charity and owns the Mater Uncancer Smiling ("**MUS**") fundraising program.
- B.** "**Event**" means *Smiddy Challenge New Zealand 2027* ride, which is not a competitive timed race, to be held between **23rd to 27th February 2027** and any scheduled training sessions run by Mater Uncancer Smiddy. The event will be held in the following locations in New Zealand:
- Commencing out of South Auckland approx. 20 kms from the Auckland Airport, the 2027 MUS ride seeks to travel along and through some of the coastal areas near Auckland before travelling southeast to eventually finish at Rotorua. Participants finishing their trip will travel approx. 200km back to Auckland.
- C.** "**Claims**" means all claims, liabilities, demands, suits, causes of action, damages, debts, costs, verdicts and judgments whatsoever whether at law or in equity or under any statute in connection with or arising out of the Event.
- D.** "**Releases**" means Mater Foundation and any promoters, organisers, participants, sanctioning organizations, officials, rescue personnel, sponsors, advertisers, event inspectors, underwriters, consultants, contractors and any others who give recommendations or engage in risk evaluation regarding the Event.

SUBMISSION OF THIS FORM OR YOUR ACCEPTANCE OF THESE TERMS ELECTRONICALLY IS YOUR ACKNOWLEDGEMENT OF THE ACCEPTANCE OF THE TERMS & CONDITIONS OF PARTICIPATION IN THE EVENT.

1. Participant details

I wish to participate in the Event and understand that participation has inherent risks, including but not limited to risks to personal health arising from the physical nature of the Event, e.g. falling or being knocked off my bike, risk of collision with vehicles and other objects etc.

2. Agreements for the Protection of Participants

- I am aware of the fitness level required to undertake the Event and certify that I am physically capable of participating in the Event and accept all risks associated with it.
- I am aware that as a participant of the Event, I and my possessions, including my bike, are not covered by Mater Foundation's insurance.
- I understand that if I reside in Australia (not a NZ resident), I will be required to purchase Travel Insurance covering travel for the entire duration of the Event with an authorised provider as the Event is held in New Zealand.
 - I understand that I may be asked to provide my Travel Insurance policy number to Mater Foundation.
 - I understand that it is my responsibility to ensure that the Insurer notes the Mater Uncancer Smiddy Event is covered as a touring, charity cycling event that is not a timed/competitive race.

- I acknowledge that I will require a valid passport to travel to New Zealand, and I understand the entry requirements for [Australian citizens and permanent residents travelling to New Zealand](#). I understand there will be entry requirements if I am not travelling on an Australian passport:

- I also understand that Mater Foundation recommends I assess my circumstances and obtain further personal insurances for the Event with an authorised provider/s, at my own discretion and risk. This could include, but not limited to:
 - Private health insurance
 - Income protection insurance
 - Cyclist personal accident insurance (including 3rd Party Liability insurance)
- I warrant that I am in a good state of health, that I am not receiving any medication or taking any substance which may affect or interfere with my ability to engage in the Event and, other than as advised to Mater Foundation, that I am free from any injury, medical condition (including but not limited to advanced pregnancy, heart condition or seizures), disability, disease or illness which may be aggravated by participation in the Event or which may affect or interfere with my ability to engage in the Event.
- I certify that I have no known or knowable physical or mental conditions that would affect my ability to safely participate in the Event, or that would result in my participation creating a risk of danger to myself or to others.
- I acknowledge that the Mater Foundation recommends and encourages each client to get medical clearance from his/her personal physician prior to participation.
- I assert that I have not been advised or cautioned against participating by a medical practitioner.
- I understand that it is my responsibility to continuously monitor my own physical and mental condition during the Event and I agree to withdraw immediately and to notify appropriate personnel if at any point my continued participation would create a risk of danger to myself or to others.
- In the event of an injury to me, I authorise treatment from event emergency medical personnel.
- In the event of an injury to me that renders me unconscious or incapable of making a medical decision, I authorise Mater Foundation personnel and emergency medical personnel at the event to make emergency medical decisions on my behalf (including, but not limited to CPR and AED).
- I authorise to secure emergency medical care or transportation when deemed necessary by Mater Foundation personnel.
- As part of any treatment from emergency medical personnel, I authorise my personal details to be collected and stored by emergency medical personnel and/or Mater Foundation as necessary for the event and in accordance with their respective privacy policies.
- I agree to take full responsibility and assume liability for any and all costs incurred as a result of my participation in the Event.
- I acknowledge that MUST have instituted its rules and safety procedures for the protection of the participant and co-participants. I confirm that prior to participating in this Event that I will familiarise myself with those rules and safety procedures and follow them throughout the

event. I also recognise the authority of the Mater Foundation to halt my participation if my participation, conduct, or presence endangers myself or my co-participants.

- I am aware that this Event involves extended strenuous physical activity that may cause me to experience fatigue like symptoms which may continue past the end date of the Event. I may not be able to undertake tasks such as operating motorised equipment safely in the days immediately after the Event.
- I warrant that I have a post-event recovery plan to safely overcome any fatigue like symptoms resulting from my participation in the event. I release Mater Foundation from any liability from any incidents experienced as a result of fatigue incurred during the Event.

3. Waiver of Liability and Indemnification

In consideration of MUST accepting my entry into the Event, I absolutely release and waive any claim I might otherwise have had against Mater Foundation and any officials or volunteers associated with the Event in respect of any injury, loss or damage I might suffer arising from my participation in the Event, including any loss or damage arising from a breach of contract and/or negligence by Mater Foundation personnel or volunteers.

I will also indemnify and hold harmless Mater Foundation against any loss or damage claimed against it by third parties as a result of any such claim made by me during the Event or arising from any action or negligence caused by me during the Event.

4. Traffic & Road Laws

I agree to follow all traffic and road laws including directions by local New Zealand Police, Mater Foundation staff and volunteers. I understand that failure to do so may result in my being removed from the Event.

5. Fundraising

I acknowledge that acceptance of this entry form and registration to take part in the Event carries with it an obligation to meet a minimum fundraising target of **A\$5,000**;

I commit to fundraising the above minimum fundraising target and accept that my failure to do so by 5.00pm Monday, 22 February 2027 will grant the Mater Foundation the right to issue an invoice with the shortfall.

I understand that my failure to lodge the fundraising target may render me ineligible to participate in the Event and I may forfeit my entry and associated entry fee.

I understand that all donations processed by Mater Foundation are non-transferable and non-refundable, even if I do not participate in the event.

6. Health Directions, Vaccinations and Weather

I acknowledge and agree that:

- (a) I will comply with all applicable Commonwealth and/or State health directions relating to vaccinations (including but not limited to; Covid-19) for the Event and a failure to do so may mean I cannot participate in the Event;
- (b) the Event may have to be cancelled (including public health order or inclement weather) due to causes beyond the control of Mater Foundation.

Should this occur, Mater Foundation will work with registered participants to do one of the following:

- i. Reschedule the event to another date and/or location and transfer participants registration;
- ii. Provide a refund of the registration fee, less any expenses incurred for participant specific items, such as custom cycling clothing.
- iii. Offer participants the option to have their Registration Fee converted to a donation to Mater Foundation.

7. Fee Refunds

If I am unable to participate in the Event after accepting these terms and conditions, I undertake to notify MUST of my inability to participate at the earliest possible opportunity. I acknowledge that a cancellation fee will be incurred:

- A cancellation fee of 25% of the full registration fee due and payable upon date of registration will be incurred for cancellations advised up until 5.00 pm Friday 28th August 2026
- A cancellation fee of 50% of the full registration fee due and payable upon date of registration will be incurred upon cancellations advised after 5.00pm Friday 28th August 2026 until 5.00 pm Friday 20th November 2026;
- A cancellation fee of 75% of the full registration fee due and payable upon date of registration will be incurred upon cancellations advised after 5.00pm Friday 20th November 2026 until 5.00 pm Friday 15th January 2027;
- I understand that I am not entitled to any refunds on my entry fee from 5.00 pm Friday 15th January 2027.

8. Right to refuse application

I acknowledge that Mater Foundation reserves the right to refuse my application to register. Should my application be refused my full registration fee will be refunded to me.

9. Media and photography

I hereby grant to Mater Foundation the right, permission, and authority to use my name, image, voice, and/or likeness, without compensation, captured during the Event and its affiliated entities or contractors, and/or the media in any photographs, videotapes, CDs, DVDs, broadcast, telecast, podcast, webcast, recordings, motion pictures, commercial advertisement, promotion materials, and/or any other record of the Event for the purposes of promoting Mater Foundation's fundraising programs.

I acknowledge my personal information, including photos, is collected, held and used by Mater Foundation for event coordination and administration purposes, Mater Foundation event marketing and Mater Foundation fundraising activities.

10. Communication

11. Majority Age

I affirm that I am 18 years of age (or will be at the time of the Event) or older and have read and understood what is expected of me and I agree to adhere to the direction of Mater Foundation personnel at all times.

11. Acknowledgment of Understanding

THIS WAIVER AND RELEASE SHALL BE INTERPRETED AND THE RIGHTS OF THE PARTIES DETERMINED UNDER THE LAW OF QUEENSLAND. THE QUEENSLAND COURTS SHALL HAVE EXCLUSIVE JURISDICTION FOR ANY DISPUTE ARISING UNDER, OR PERTAINING TO, THIS WAIVER AND RELEASE.
