# Inspiration – ways to fundraise

### Ticket sales

 Selling tickets to your event is a great way to increase the proceeds to go towards your fundraising target.

## Raffles

 A raffle is a great way to maximise your funds raised. Try to get your prizes donated by local businesses and make them attractive to your audience.

### Auctions

- You can choose to have an auction at your event. The most common auctions are:
  - Silent auctions—the items are displayed on the table at your event—all you have to do is create a bidding form to be displayed with each item.
  - Live auctions—generally, they work best at larger events with high ticket items and just a few items to bid on.

### Head or tails

Ask your guests to donate to play.
Your guests just need to guess
 whether the coin flip will result in
 heads (put hands on head) or tails
 (put hands on tail). This keeps going
 until one person remains standing.
 The winner gets a prize.
