The closing date for registration is Friday, 1 May 2026 unless sold out prior.

Registrations are non-refundable if cancelled.

Requests for team registrations submitted after Friday, 1 May 2026 will be at the discretion of the Event Organiser and must be paid for immediately by credit card.

Once team registrations have been purchased and confirmed, should you be unable to attend Golf for Miracles Charity Golf Day, replacement players are welcome. Any substitution of players must be notified in writing to Mater Foundation before Friday, 1 May 2026
