



Terms and Conditions – 2026 Mater Brisbane to Gold Coast Cycle for Cancer - *Tour de Fundraising promotion (Queensland residents only)*

1. Entry into the 2026 Brisbane to Gold Coast Cycle for Cancer (BNEtoGC) **Tour de Fundraising** (“**Promotion**”) is deemed to be an acceptance of these Conditions of Entry. Information on how to enter the Promotion and prizes associated with the Promotion form part of these Conditions of Entry.
2. Entries for the Promotion commence at 10:00hrs AEST Monday 20 July 2026 and close at 09:59hrs AEST Sunday 26 July 2026 (“**Promotion Period**”).
3. Entry is open to all BNEtoGC participants (“**Entrants**”) who are residents of Queensland, Australia and over the age of 18 years on Monday 20 July 2026.
4. Directors, officers, management, employees and other staff (and the immediate families of directors, officers, management, employees and other staff) of Mater Foundation and their related bodies corporate and agents are ineligible to enter.
5. The Promoter reserves the right in their sole discretion to disqualify any individual who the Promoter have reason to believe breached any of these conditions or engaged in any unlawful or otherwise improper misconduct calculated to jeopardise the fair and proper conduct of the competition. The Promoter's legal rights to recover damages or other compensation from such an offender are reserved.
6. To enter, Entrants must receive a total donation value of \$100.00 or greater to their BNEtoGC individual fundraising page at www.BNEtoGC.com.au during the promotion period.
7. Any Donation/s made by the Entrant, to the Entrant's own fundraising page (“Self-donation/s”) are excluded from eligibility in this Promotion.
8. Multiple entries are permitted.
9. There is one (1) major prize winner (“**Major Prize Winner**”).
10. The total prize pool is valued at \$4499.00
11. Major Prize Winner will receive:

13. The Major Prize Winners will be advised within five (5) business days of the draw and their name may be published on www.BNEtoGC.com.au
14. The Major Prize Winners will be contacted by email with details of how to claim their prize.
15. Entries must be received by the Promoters within the Promotion Period. Entries are deemed to be received upon a verified donation being received to a participants individual fundraising page at www.BNEtoGC.com.au during the promotion period.
16. Prizes
 - 16.1. The value of the prize pool is accurate at the date of commencement of the Promotion Period. The Promoter accepts no responsibility for any variation in the value of the Prize after that date.
 - 16.2. The Prize cannot be transferred, exchanged or redeemed for cash.
 - 16.3. The Promoter's decision is final and no correspondence will be entered into, including in the event of a dispute.
 - 16.4. The prize must be collected in person from a 99 Bikes store within Australia.
 - 16.5. The winner must collect the prize from 99 Bikes within 60 days from the draw date. Failure to do so may result in the prize being forfeited with Mater Foundation reserving the right to collect the prize back from 99 Bikes. Clause 16.11 outlines the steps the Promoter will follow if the prize Winner is not able to be contacted to redeem the Major Prize.

- 16.6. No rain checks, holds, or custom orders will be offered in relation to the prize.
- 16.7. By accepting the prize, the winner agrees to comply with these terms and conditions and any reasonable instructions provided by 99 Bikes in relation to prize collection or substitution.
- 16.8. The prize is subject to availability. If the specified model, size or colour is not available, 99 Bikes reserves the right to substitute the prize with a product of same or greater value and specifications, at its sole discretion.
- 16.9. If for any reason the prize is not used by the expiry date identified on the voucher, the prize, or any remaining portion of the prize will be forfeited.
- 16.10. The Promoter accepts no responsibility for lost or stolen vouchers.
- 16.11. Where Mater Foundation is unable to verify or contact a winner or any prize remains unclaimed after all reasonable attempts have been made to locate or otherwise contact the winner, the prize/s will be held for at least 3 months, after which time the Promoter will hold an unclaimed prize draw to select an alternative winner. The unclaimed prize draw will be held at 10:00hrs AEST, Wednesday 11 November 2026 at 14 Stratton Street, Newstead, 4006 or remotely by Microsoft Teams. The alternative winner will be notified by phone and email within 5 days of the unclaimed prize draw about the amount of the prize and of the time and place at which it may be collected.
The redrawn winner will have 60 days to redeem the Major Prize from the Promoters supplier 99 Bikes, otherwise it will be forfeited.

17. Entry to Promotion

- 17.1. The Promoter reserves the right to validate and check the authenticity of entries and to disqualify any entrant for tampering with the entry process.
- 17.2. The Promoter and its associated agencies or companies accept no responsibility for lost, late, stolen, damaged or misdirected entries.
- 17.3. The Promoter has no control over internet or mobile telecommunications, network lines, bugs, viruses or server problems, and accepts no responsibility for any problems associated with them, for whatever reason.
- 17.4. Any entry that is lodged by automatic, repetitive, robotic, programmed or similar methods will be deemed void as determined in the absolute discretion of the Promoter.
- 17.5. All entries become the property of the Promoter.

18. No Liability

- 18.1. If any act or omission, event or circumstance occurs which is beyond the reasonable control of the Promoter and which prevents the Promoter from complying with these Conditions of Entry, the Promoter will not be liable for any failure to perform or any delay in performing its obligations.
- 18.2. The Promoter reserves the right, subject to any applicable law, to cancel, terminate, modify or suspend the Promotion.
- 18.3. The Promoter will not be liable for any loss or damage whatsoever which is suffered, including but not limited to indirect or consequential loss, or for any personal injury suffered or sustained as a result of receiving, taking or using any Prize except for any liability which cannot be excluded by law.
- 18.4. The Promoter accepts no responsibility for any tax liability incurred as a result of participating in this Promotion. Any tax liability arising as a result of accepting any Prize is the responsibility of the Winner.

19. Consent
