

PARTICIPANT TERMS AND CONDITIONS

MATER'S BRISBANE TO GOLD COAST CYCLE FOR CANCER | SUNDAY 23 August 2026

Before You Ride, At a Glance:

- **By registering, you accept the full Terms and Conditions**, including waivers, safety rules and event requirements for the 23 August 2026 event.
- **This is not a race.** Roads remain open to traffic, riders must follow Queensland road rules and official directions at all times.
- **Minimum capability applies.** Riders must be fit to participate, maintain an average pace of 17 km/h, and ride a road-worthy bike.
- **Eligible bikes only.** Human-powered bikes and compliant e-bikes are allowed. No scooters, no track/velodrome/Time Trial Bikes, and no bikes with tri or aero bars; no trailers, child seats or animals.
- **Age limits apply.** Riders must be 18+, or 16–17 with parent or guardian consent with special conditions. Under 16s cannot participate.
- **Ride at your own risk.** Cycling involves inherent risks, participants are responsible for their own health, safety and medical costs.
- **Insurance is mandatory.** Riders must hold their own cycling insurance or opt into the event's 1-day Bicycle Queensland cover (Fee applies - \$14 incl GST).
- **Refunds are limited.** Withdrawals before 7 August 2026 receive a 50% refund of registration fees only. No refunds after this date.
- **Fundraising and conduct rules apply.** Donations are non-refundable, fundraising activities must comply with Queensland laws, and misconduct may result in removal.
- **Photos, communications and data use.** Event photos may be used for promotion, and participant details are used for event and fundraising communications in line with privacy laws.

Entry into Mater's Brisbane to Gold Coast Cycle for Cancer is deemed to be an acceptance of these Terms and Conditions of Entry.

Definitions

- A. "Mater Foundation" means Mater Foundation Ltd as trustee for Mater Foundation (ABN 96 723 184 640) 14 Stratton Street, Newstead, 4006.
- B. Mater's Brisbane to Gold Coast Cycle for Cancer event to be held on Sunday 23 August 2026.
- C. "Claims" means all claims, liabilities, demands, suits, causes of action, damages, debts, costs, verdicts and judgments whatsoever whether at law or in equity or under any statute in connection with or arising out of Mater's Brisbane to Gold Coast Cycle for Cancer.
- D. "Releasees" means Mater Foundation and any promoters, organisers, participants, sanctioning organisations, officials, rescue personnel, sponsors, advertisers, event inspectors, underwriters, consultants and any others who give recommendations or engage in risk evaluation regarding the Brisbane to Gold Coast Cycle for Cancer and the owners, occupiers and lessees of any premises used and their respective directors, servants, employees and agents.

SUBMISSION OF THIS FORM, OR YOUR ACCEPTANCE OF THESE TERMS ELECTRONICALLY, IS YOUR ACKNOWLEDGEMENT OF THE ACCEPTANCE OF THE TERMS & CONDITIONS AND ACCURACY OF INFORMATION, FOR PARTICIPATION IN THE BRISBANE TO GOLD COAST CYCLE FOR CANCER EVENT.

1. Participant Details

- 1.1. I wish to participate in Mater's Brisbane to Gold Coast Cycle for Cancer and understand that participation has inherent risks, including but not limited to risks to my personal health arising from the physical nature of Mater's Brisbane to Gold Coast Cycle for Cancer event.
- 1.2. I acknowledge that all information entered via Mater's Brisbane to Gold Coast Cycle for Cancer website as part of the process for registering myself and/or any other invited person/s for the event, is accurate at the time of entering. This includes the confirmation that you have sought the consent to enter the information of invited event ticket holder/s.

Late changes to participant information may incur additional fees and may prevent the accurate delivery of rider packs or merchandise.

- 1.3. I acknowledge that it is my responsibility to ensure all personal details provided, including but not limited to contact information, delivery address, emergency contact details and merchandise sizing, are accurate and up to date by any published cut-off dates. Mater Foundation is not responsible for errors, delays, additional costs or lost items resulting from incorrect or late information updates submitted after these cut-off dates.
- 1.4. Late changes to participant information may incur additional fees and may prevent the accurate delivery of rider packs or merchandise.

2. Event and Conduct

- 2.1. The Event is not a race and roads used will not be closed to traffic. Participation in the Event involves riding with other traffic and other cyclists in close proximity. I acknowledge and accept the hazards involved. I must ride in a safe, responsible and courteous manner during the Event, and I agree to abide by the Queensland road rules and to follow directions given by Mater Foundation, traffic control and Queensland Police.
- 2.2. I must be able to maintain a minimum overall average speed of 17km per hour. Progressive closing times for locations along the bike route will be noted. If the I fall behind these closing times, I must either board the Event Support Vehicle for transportation further along the route or make private arrangements to safely leave the event.
- 2.3. It is my responsibility to have available, as I need, water, suitable food and/or medication which may be necessary to treat any particular medical condition from which I suffer.
- 2.4. I must ensure my bicycle is in sound mechanical condition prior to and on the Event.
- 2.5. Start line for the 2026 event: On the South East Busway I must enter from the Event start on Grey Street and cannot enter from one of the stations. I must not travel against the flow or in the north bound lane unless directed to do so by Queensland Police or Traffic Management.
- 2.6. I acknowledge that the use of any form of headphone listening device is not permitted during the Event.
- 2.7. Only standard human-powered or electric power-assisted bicycles, unicycles or tricycles are permitted on the Event. Scooters, combustion engines and power-assisted drives capable of generating over 250 watts are not permitted on the Event. Refer to Legal motorised bicycles in the Queensland bicycle road rules.
- 2.8. All e-bikes must comply with Australian Standards with a top assisted speed of 25km/hr.
- 2.9. Riding on a tagalong, in a bicycle trailer or child seat is not permitted.
- 2.10. Track/Velodrome, Time Trial Bikes, and Bikes with tri or aero bars are not permitted.
- 2.11. Private support vehicles are not permitted along the bike route or at rest stops.
- 2.12. Animals are not permitted on the Event course.
- 2.13. The Event will be held outdoors and will proceed regardless of poor weather. Only extreme weather may cause cancellation. I accept that conditions in which the Event is conducted may vary without warning. In the rare occurrence of an event cancellation, all participants will be contacted via email and/or SMS and a message will be posted on the event website and social media pages. (refer to Item 10. Event Cancellation for additional details regarding event cancellation)
- 2.14. I authorise Mater Foundation to disclose my personal details to authorised event organisers to view only for the purposes of managing event and safety command operations on Sunday 23 August 2026.
- 2.15. I acknowledge that event identification provided must be worn, with bike numbers fully visible from the front.
- 2.16. If you do not complete the course within the allowed event times you will be asked to remove your bike number and event identification. You may stay on the course, but this is at your own risk and you will be unsupported.

- 2.17. Conduct which, in the opinion of Mater Foundation, has, may or will result in a breach of these Entry Terms, harm or damage to any Participant or their property, illegal activity, bad language, or other antisocial behaviour, may result in the participants' removal from the Event.
- 2.18. You must not conduct any unreasonable, disruptive or unlawful commercial or political activity at the event. Failure to do so may result in the participants' removal from the Event.
- 2.19. I understand that the course, including start line location, are subject to change. Should changes be made, Mater Foundation will update participants accordingly.

3. Acknowledgement and Certification

- 3.1. I am aware of the fitness level required to undertake Mater's Brisbane to Gold Coast Cycle for Cancer and certify that I am physically capable of participating in the event and accept all risks associated with my participation in it.
- 3.2. I acknowledge that whilst Mater Foundation and associated Event Managers utilises roaming mechanics, course marshals, QPS, QAS and other support vehicles to provide event support, Mater Foundation will not be able to track my precise GPS location throughout the entire Event.
- 3.3. I warrant that I am in a good state of health, that I am not receiving any medication or taking any substance which may affect or interfere with my ability to engage in Mater's Brisbane to Gold Coast Cycle for Cancer and, other than as set out below, that I am free from any injury, medical condition (including but not limited to advanced pregnancy, heart condition or seizures), disability, disease or illness which may be aggravated by participation in the event or which may affect or interfere with my ability to engage in the event.
- 3.4. I certify that I have no known or knowable physical or mental conditions that would affect my ability to safely participate in the event, or that would result in my participation creating a risk of danger to myself or to others.
- 3.5. I acknowledge that the Mater Foundation recommends and encourages each rider to get medical clearance from his/her/their personal physician prior to participation.
- 3.6. I assert that I have not been advised or cautioned against participating by a medical practitioner.
- 3.7. I understand that it is my responsibility to continuously monitor my own physical and mental condition during Mater's Brisbane to Gold Coast Cycle for Cancer, and I agree to withdraw immediately and to notify appropriate personnel if at any point my continued participation would create a risk of danger to myself or to others.
- 3.8. In the event of an injury to me, I authorise treatment from event emergency medical personnel.
- 3.9. In the event of an injury to me that renders me unconscious or incapable of making a medical decision, I authorise appropriate Mater Foundation personnel and emergency medical personnel at Mater's Brisbane to Gold Coast Cycle for Cancer to make emergency medical decisions on my behalf (including, but not limited to CPR and AED).
- 3.10. I authorise to secure emergency medical care or transportation (i.e., QAS) when deemed necessary by Mater Foundation or Event personnel and to notify my emergency contact if I am not able.
- 3.11. As part of any treatment from emergency medical personnel, I authorise my personal details to be collected and stored by emergency medical personnel and/or Mater Foundation as necessary for the event and in accordance with their respective privacy policies.
- 3.12. I agree to take full responsibility and assume liability for any and all costs incurred as a result of my participation in Mater's Brisbane to Gold Coast Cycle for Cancer.
- 3.13. I acknowledge that Mater Foundation have instituted its rules and safety procedures for the protection of the participant and co-participants. I confirm that prior to participating in Mater's Brisbane to Gold Coast Cycle for Cancer that I will familiarise myself with those rules and safety procedures and follow them throughout the event. I agree at all times during Mater's Brisbane to Gold Coast Cycle for Cancer to comply with the directions of anyone appointed or permitted by the Foundation to organise the event, following all traffic and road laws including directions by Police, Mater Foundation staff and volunteers and recognise that Mater Foundation personnel may halt my participation (and, if necessary, have me removed from the course and premises) if my participation, conduct, or presence endangers myself or my co-participants.

4. Personal property

- 4.1. Mater Foundation will use their best endeavours to take due care in handling bikes and personal property transported during the Event, but is not responsible for any loss, damage, cost or expense that I may suffer or incur as a result of Mater and Mater Foundation employees, volunteers, and/or sub-contractors or a contractor working on Mater Foundation's behalf handling your bike or personal property.

5. Participant Insurances

- 5.1. As part of my Event registration, I understand that I was provided two options regarding mandated participant event insurance; either to
- Indicate that I already hold, or will hold my own Personal Accident and/or Public Liability & Professional Indemnity (3rd Party) Liability insurance, valid on the Event date of Sunday 23 August 2026, through a provider such as Bicycle QLD or AusCycling;
 - or
 - Opt in cover for \$14 including GST, via 1 day Bicycle QLD (V-Insurance) Membership. This includes: Personal Accident, Income Protection, Public Liability & Professional Indemnity (3rd Party) Liability Insurance. I authorise Mater Foundation to transfer my personal details to Bicycle QLD for the purposes of membership administration.

BQ Membership & Insurance – 1 day

- 5.2. The opt in BQ Membership 1 day Insurance (V-Insurance) includes Personal Accident, Income Protection, Public Liability & Professional Indemnity (3rd Party) Liability Insurance.
- 5.3. This cover does not cover personal equipment or belongings including but not limited to bicycles, mobile phones, bike computers, smart watches, clothing, cycling accessories.
- 5.4. This insurance cover is valid for Sunday 23 August 2026.
- 5.5. Claim excess (V-Insurance): \$50 excess applies to each injury. \$Nil excess applies if the participant/member has cover under an Australian Private Health Fund.
- 5.6. With regards to claims for Non-Medicare Medical Expenses under the BQ Membership Insurance: This covers insured persons for NON-MEDICARE medical expenses. The policy is for reimbursement only. That is, the member must pay the account first then submit a claim for reimbursement.
- 5.7. I understand that it is my responsibility to make myself aware of the policy wording and inclusions relating to this cover, which includes Loss of Income cover. A copy of the BQ Membership Insurance – Summary of Cover is available at <https://bq.org.au/bike-riding-insurance/>.

6. Majority Age

- 6.1. I affirm that I will be 18 years of age or older at the time of Mater's Brisbane to Gold Coast Cycle for Cancer. If I am 16 or 17 yrs of age at the time of event, I understand a parent or guardian must accept this Waiver and Release of Liability on my behalf. I have read and understood what is expected of me and I agree to adhere to the direction of Mater Foundation and/or Event personnel at all times.
- 6.2. Children under the age of 16 years at the time of the event are not permitted to participate.
- 6.3. Persons aged 16-17 at the time of the Event can participate in the 100Km course. They do not need to be accompanied by an adult guardian during the Event, but require the consent of their parent or guardian to participate. Additionally, a mobile phone must be carried by the participant to allow line of communication to parent or guardian, if required for any reason.

7. Purchasing entries on behalf of others

- 7.1. I acknowledge that, should I purchase entries to Mater's Brisbane to Gold Coast Cycle for Cancer on behalf of others, I must gain their consent to do so.
- 7.2. By making this purchase, I am accepting these Participant Terms and Conditions on their behalf.
- 7.3. I understand that a fundraising page may be created on their behalf and the participant(s) I am purchasing entries for will receive email and SMS communication from Mater Foundation, including a link to a copy of these Participant Terms and Conditions, event information and fundraising communication.

8. Merchandise

- 8.1. I acknowledge Mater Foundation has pre-ordered event branded merchandise and I understand that best endeavours will be made to provide me with my preferred merchandise size, should I meet eligibility criteria. Should my allocated size be unavailable the closest size will be allocated to me.
- 8.2. I acknowledge that Mater Foundation uses authorised Merchandise & Mailhouse service providers to work with their delivery partners to send the B2GC Jersey and event collateral utilising my nominated address. Our privacy policy is available at www.materfoundation.org.au/privacy.
- 8.3. For merchandise purchased as part of registration or through the participant's personal dashboard at www.b2gc.com.au, Conditions of Purchase are available at www.b2gc.com.au. Please refer to these conditions of purchase for information about product returns outside of Australian Consumer Law.

- 8.4. I acknowledge that **fundraising incentives** (including but not limited to Honor Roll Jerseys, Champions Club Cycling Caps, Water Bottles and Honour Roll recognition or other rewards) are subject to eligibility criteria, fundraising cut-off dates and stock availability. Meeting a fundraising minimum does not guarantee receipt of an incentive where eligibility is met after published cut-off dates or where fulfilment is no longer possible. All incentives are provided on a best endeavours basis and are not refundable or transferable.

9. Participant withdrawals & Refunds

- 9.1. If I wish to withdraw from Mater's Brisbane to Gold Coast Cycle for Cancer I must do so in writing (via email) to Mater Foundation (brisbanetogoldcoast@mater.org.au) before midnight Friday 7 August 2026. Rider identification envelopes received must be returned to Mater Foundation before the Event to receive any refund.

The following cancellation policy will apply:

- A 50% cancellation fee will be incurred if I withdraw before midnight Friday 7 August 2026.
 - No refund will be provided if I withdraw after midnight Friday 7 August 2026.
 - Refunds apply to registration fees only. Merchandise purchased during registration is non-refundable.
- 9.2. I understand that Mater Foundation will consider offering a refund outside this policy (Clause 9.1) for a participant for any exceptional circumstances, at their discretion and with supporting evidence. This could include for compassionate, medical or pregnancy/fertility treatment reasons.
- 9.3. I understand that my application to participate and my application fee cannot be transferred to another person (all entries are non-transferrable).
- 9.4. A \$10 administration fee may be charged to re-issue rider identification envelopes if the incorrect or incomplete address details have been provided during the entry process.

10. Cancellation and Changes

- 10.1. I acknowledge that Mater Foundation reserves the right to cancel or postpone the Brisbane to Gold Coast Cycle for Cancer in the event of unforeseen circumstances including but not limited to:
- I. Poor weather
 - II. Theft
 - III. Disaster
 - IV. Accident
 - V. Strike;
 - VI. Civil disruption;
 - VII. Pandemic or public health order; or
 - VIII. Recommendations of any government authority or agency;
- 10.2. In the event of a cancellation or postponement I acknowledge that Mater Foundation will use reasonable efforts to minimise the cost to me, but I acknowledge that certain costs may not be refunded.
- 10.3. I acknowledge Mater Foundation may need to change the event format, course or other Brisbane to Gold Coast Cycle for Cancer conditions at its discretion. If this occurs, these terms and conditions apply to the changed conditions.
- 10.4. In the circumstance that Mater Foundation chooses to cancel the event, Mater Foundation will work with registered participants to do one of the following:
- A. Reschedule the event to another date and transfer participants registration;
 - B. Provide a refund of the registration fee, less any expenses incurred for participant specific items, such as rider kit already provided to participants.
 - C. Offer participants the option to have their registration fee converted to a donation to Mater Foundation.
- 10.5. I acknowledge that Mater Foundation reserves the right to refuse my application and refund the registration fee back to me.

11. Fundraising

- 11.1. I understand that all donations processed by Mater Foundation are non-transferable and non-refundable, even if I do not participate in the event.

I understand and acknowledge that if I hold any fundraising activities in conjunction with or related to the event I agree to the below requirements:

- A. All raffles and similar fundraising activities are to be conducted in accordance with relevant legislation in Queensland the Charitable and Non-Profit Gaming Act 1999. Queensland Government information available at: <https://www.business.qld.gov.au/industry/liquor-gaming/gaming/not-profit-charitable/competitions-raffles-bingo>;
- B. Any activities where liquor is to be consumed or sold must be in accordance with relevant legislation. A Community Liquor Permit may be required and is available from OLGR for \$55.40 (one day fee) 21 days prior to the event. For more information please see <https://www.business.qld.gov.au/industry/liquor-gaming/liquor> raised on behalf of Mater Foundation should be held in a safe secure place, prior to being deposited directly into the Mater Foundation bank account;
- C. Mater Foundation and/or Mater Misericordiae Ltd will not be held responsible for any financial losses, damage to property or personal injury suffered as a result of the fundraising activities; and
- D. Any costs incurred by the organiser of a fundraising activity is at the expense of the organiser and not Mater Foundation.

12. Communication

- 12.1. I understand that my email address and mobile phone number will be used for registration confirmation and updates about Mater's Brisbane to Gold Coast Cycle for Cancer as well as support to help me reach my fundraising and training goals. From time-to-time Mater Foundation may also send me information on other events and fundraising activities that may be of interest by email or electronic text message (SMS).
- 12.2. I am aware if I do not want to receive further communication from Mater Foundation (other than information that relates to Mater's Brisbane to Gold Coast Cycle for Cancer) I can contact the Mater Foundation Supporter Operations team via foundation@mater.org.au or by calling 07 3163 5666.
- 12.3. I am aware if I have any questions about privacy, including updating and/or changing my personal information or obtaining a copy of the Mater Privacy Policy I can contact the Mater Foundation Privacy Officer via email to: FoundationPrivacy@mater.org.au or by calling 07 3163 5666.
- 12.4. Persons under the age of 18 will not be contacted regarding fundraising in line with the Fundraising Institute of Australia (FIA) Code.

13. Special offers

- 13.1. Mater Foundation has the right to offer special promotional offers throughout the marketing campaigns as incentives to different groups of participants. These offers include value additions and registration discounts. These offers may not be available to all participants at all times and can be added or removed at the discretion of Mater Foundation.

14. Media, Photography and Promotion

- 14.1. I acknowledge that my event fundraising page is publicly accessible and may display my name, fundraising total, messages and other content submitted by me or on my behalf.
- 14.2. I further acknowledge that my full name, as provided to Mater Foundation, may be used to publicly recognise me in connection with the event, including on-course and event-related digital and print materials such as course signage or finishers' village screens, unless I advise Mater Foundation that I do not consent to this use.
I grant to Mater Foundation and its affiliated entities or contractors and/or the media my permission and authority to use my name, image, voice, and/or likeness in any photographs, videotapes, CDs, DVDs, broadcast, telecast, podcast, webcast, recordings, motion pictures, commercial advertisement, promotion materials, and/or any other record captured during the Brisbane to Gold Coast Cycle for Cancer for any purpose whatsoever without compensation, for a period of 24 months from the 2026 event date.
- 14.3. I acknowledge my personal information, including photos, is collected, held and used by Mater Foundation for event coordination and administration purposes, Mater Foundation event marketing and Mater Foundation fundraising activities.

I acknowledge that my full name, as provided to Mater Foundation for my event active public fundraising webpage, may be used on the event course across digital and print items such as course signage or finishers' village screen to publicly recognise me, unless I advise Mater Foundation that I do not consent to this signage use.

15. Health Directions and Vaccinations

15.1. I acknowledge that 'Mater Foundation' have instituted its rules and safety procedures for the protection of the participant and co-participants. I confirm that prior to participating in this Event that I will familiarise myself with those rules and safety procedures and follow them throughout the event. I also recognise the authority of the Mater Foundation to halt my participation if my participation, conduct, or presence endangers myself or my co-participants.

16. Waiver of Liability and Indemnification

- 16.1. In consideration of Mater Foundation accepting my entry (including accuracy of information) into Mater's Brisbane to Gold Coast Cycle for Cancer, I absolutely release and waive any Claim I might otherwise have against the Releasees in respect of any injury, death, loss or damage I suffer as a result of my participation in Mater's Brisbane to Gold Coast Cycle for Cancer, howsoever arising, including any loss or damage arising from a breach of contract and/or negligence by the Releasees.
- 16.2. I indemnify and hold harmless the Releasees against any loss or damage suffered by them as a result of any Claim made by or against me during Mater's Brisbane to Gold Coast Cycle for Cancer howsoever arising, including as a result of any act, neglect or default caused by me during the event.
- 16.3. I acknowledge that under the Civil Liability Act 2003 (Qld), the Releasees will not be liable for any harm suffered by me due to the materialisation of an obvious risk to my participation in a dangerous recreational activity. I acknowledge that participation in the Brisbane to Gold Coast Cycle for Cancer is a recreational activity that carries risk to the rider.

17. Acknowledgement of Understanding

THIS WAIVER AND RELEASE SHALL BE INTERPRETED AND THE RIGHTS OF THE PARTIES DETERMINED UNDER THE LAW OF QUEENSLAND. THE QUEENSLAND COURTS SHALL HAVE EXCLUSIVE JURISDICTION FOR ANY DISPUTE ARISING UNDER, OR PERTAINING TO, THIS WAIVER AND RELEASE.

I have carefully read these Terms and Conditions, including the Waiver of Liability and Indemnification, and fully understand its contents. I am aware that this is a release of liability and binding contract between myself and the persons and entities mentioned above and I sign it of my own free will. I understand that I am giving up substantial rights, including my right to sue.

I acknowledge that I am accepting this Waiver and Release freely and voluntarily and intend by accepting to be a complete and unconditional release of all liability to the greatest extent allowed by law.

I understand if I am under 18 years of age, a parent or guardian must accept these Terms and Conditions and Waiver of Liability and Indemnification on my behalf.
