

Notice of Special Event and Possible Traffic Delays Sunday 27 August 2023

Dear Residents,

As you may be aware the Brisbane to Gold Coast Cycle for Cancer event will be celebrating its 18th year on Sunday 27 August. The event will start at Melbourne Street in South Brisbane and finish at Fisherman's Lawn in Southport. This community event is a recreational ride raising vital funds for Mater Foundation supporting cancer research, with an anticipated 5000 participants.

We encourage residents along the course to get involved with the event and cheer on the riders. As in previous years, to ensure a safe event for participants and the public there will be some road closures and changed traffic conditions across the course, start and finish areas. Please note we will endeavor to reopen the roads as early as possible to reduce the impact the event has on residents across the course. See below affected roads.
