FUNDRAISING REWARDS TERMS AND CONDITIONS

MATER'S BRISBANE TO GOLD COAST CYCLE FOR CANCER | SUNDAY 23 August 2026

Eligibility Period:

- Starts **00:01 AEST on Thursday, 30 April 2026.**
- Ends **14:00 AEST on Sunday, 23 August 2026.**
- The donations must be made to an Brisbane to Gold Coast Cycle for Cancer event fundraising page during the eligibility period.

How It Works:

- Make or receive a donation to the participants Brisbane to Gold Coast event fundraising page via the official website www.BNEtoGC.com.au.
- Ensure the donation receives a donation receipt.
- Once you reach the fundraising rewards target in donations received, you will automatically qualify for the corresponding reward level product.
\$250 or more qualifies the participant for one (1) pair of NeoPro Cycling Socks.
\$500 or more qualifies the participant for one (1) Yeti Ramble 8oz Cup.
\$750 or more qualifies the participant for one (1) 2026 Official NeoPro Honour Roll Cycling Jersey
\$1500 or more qualifies the participant for one (1) 2026 NeoPro Cycling Cap.

Notification:

- Mater Foundation will contact successful participants that they have been rewarded with the fundraising product via email notification prior to event day.

Redemptions:

- Participants will collect their rewards item from the Finishers Village Rewards Tent on event day.
- NeoPro Honour Roll jerseys reached before 7th August will be posted out to participants. Where the Honour Roll jersey reward is reached after the 7th August and before the event day, the Honour Roll Jersey will be made available to collect from the start line information tent. Where the Honour Roll jersey is reached on event day, the jersey will be available to collect from the Rewards tent at the Finishers Village on event day.

- A limited number of Honour Roll jerseys are available in each size. Where the participants nominated jersey size is not available, the next closest size will be allocated.
- NeoPro Cycling caps reached in advance of event day will be posted out to the address supplied during participant registration. Postage will take place throughout the campaign with postage to commence from July 2026.
- If a participant is unable to attend on event day due to illness or unforeseen circumstances, the participant should reach out to brisbanetogoldcoast@mater.org.au to discuss their rewards collection. Collection will be made available from the Mater Foundation Offices 14 Stratton Street, Newstead Queensland 4074 at an agreed date and time. Collection post event will not be available until stock has been returned to Mater Foundation post event which can be up to 7 business days.
