

Terms and Conditions – Participant Registration for the 2020 Bottlemart Smiddy Challenge

Entry into the 2020 Bottlemart Smiddy Challenge with Mater Foundation's program "Smiling for Smiddy" is deemed to be an acceptance of Terms and Conditions of Entry.

- A. Mater Hospitals' Appeal Ltd as trustee for Mater Foundation (ABN 96 723 184 640) 620 Stanley St, Woolloongabba QLD 4102 ("**Mater Foundation**") is a registered Charity and owns the Smiling for Smiddy ("**S4S**") fundraising program.
- B. "**Event**" means the 2020 Bottlemart Smiddy Challenge to be held on 28th August – 5th September 2020 and any scheduled training sessions run by Smiling for Smiddy.
- C. "**Claims**" means all claims, liabilities, demands, suits, causes of action, damages, debts, costs, verdicts and judgments whatsoever whether at law or in equity or under any statute in connection with or arising out of the Event.
- D. "**Releasees**" means Mater Foundation, its directors, any promoters, organisers, participants, sanctioning organizations, officials, on-road services provider, rescue personnel, sponsors, advertisers, event inspectors, underwriters, volunteers, consultants and any others who give recommendations or engage in risk evaluation regarding the Event.

SUBMISSION OF THIS FORM OR YOUR ACCEPTANCE OF THESE TERMS ELECTRONICALLY IS YOUR ACKNOWLEDGEMENT OF THE ACCEPTANCE OF THE TERMS & CONDITIONS OF PARTICIPATION IN THE EVENT.

1. Participant details

I wish to participate in the Event and understand that participation has inherent risks, including but not limited to risks to personal health arising from the physical nature of the Event, e.g. falling or being knocked off my bike, risk of collision with vehicles and other objects etc.

2. Agreements for the Protection of Participants

- I am aware of the fitness level required to undertake the Event and certify that I am physically capable of participating in the Event and accept all risks associated with it.
- I am aware that as a participant of the Event, I and my possessions, including my bike, are not covered by Mater Foundation's insurance.
- I warrant that I am in a good state of health, that I am not receiving any medication or taking any substance which may affect or interfere with my ability to engage in the Event and, other than as advised to Mater Foundation, that I am free from any injury, medical condition (including but not limited to advanced pregnancy, heart condition or seizures), disability, disease or illness which may be aggravated by participation in the Event or which may affect or interfere with my ability to engage in the Event.
- I certify that I have no known or knowable physical or mental conditions that would affect my ability to safely participate in the Event, or that would result in my participation creating a risk of danger to myself or to others.
- I acknowledge that the Mater Foundation recommends and encourages each participant to get medical clearance from his/her personal physician prior to participation.
- I assert that I have not been advised or cautioned against participating by a medical practitioner.
- I understand that it is my responsibility to continuously monitor my own physical and mental condition during the Event and I agree to withdraw immediately and to notify appropriate personnel if at any point my continued participation would create a risk of danger to myself or to others.

- In the event of an injury to me that renders me unconscious or incapable of making a medical decision, I authorise Mater Foundation personnel and emergency medical personnel at the event to make emergency medical decisions on my behalf (including, but not limited to CPR and AED).
- I authorise to secure emergency medical care or transportation when deemed necessary by Mater Foundation personnel.
- I agree to take full responsibility and assume liability for any and all costs incurred as a result of my participation in the Event.
- I acknowledge that S4S have instituted its rules and safety procedures for the protection of the participant and co-participants.
I confirm that prior to participating in this Event that I will familiarise myself with those rules and safety procedures and follow them throughout the event. I also recognise the authority of the Mater Foundation or on-road service provider to halt my participation if my participation, conduct, or presence endangers myself or my co-participants.
- I am aware that this Event involves extended strenuous physical activity that may cause me to experience fatigue like symptoms which may continue past the end date of the Event. I may not be able to undertake tasks such as operating motorised equipment safely in the days immediately after the Event.
- I warrant that I have a post-event recovery plan to safely overcome any fatigue like symptoms resulting from my participation in the event. I release Mater Foundation from any liability from any incidents experienced as a result of fatigue incurred during the Event.

3. **Waiver of Liability and Indemnification**

In consideration of S4S accepting my entry into the Event, I absolutely release and waive any Claim I might otherwise have had against all Releasees in respect of any injury (including death), loss or damage I might suffer arising from my participation in the Event, including any loss or damage arising from a breach of contract and/or negligence by any Releasees.

I will also indemnify and hold harmless all Releasees against any Claim for injury (including death), loss or damage claimed against the Releasees by third parties arising from any action or negligence caused by me during the Event.

4. **Traffic & Road Laws**

I agree to follow all traffic and road laws including directions by Police, Mater Foundation staff, on-road services provider and volunteers. I understand that failure to do so may result in my being removed from the Event.

5. **Fundraising**

I acknowledge that acceptance of this entry form and registration to take part in the Event carries with it an obligation to meet a fundraising target of **A\$5,000**. I commit to fundraising **A\$5,000** and accept that my failure to do so by 5.00pm Friday, 20 March 2020 will grant the Mater Foundation the right to issue an invoice with the shortfall.

I understand that my failure to lodge the fundraising target may render me ineligible to participate in the Event and I may forfeit my entry and associated entry fee.

I understand that all donations processed by Mater Foundation are non-transferable and non-refundable, even if I do not participate in the event.

6. **Fee Refunds**

If I am unable to participate in the Event after accepting these terms and conditions, I undertake to notify S4S of my inability to participate at the earliest possible opportunity. I acknowledge that a cancellation fee will be incurred:

- \$345.00 cancellation fee will be incurred if I withdraw up until 5.00 pm Tuesday 31 March 2020
- 50% cancellation fee of the entry fee will be incurred if I withdraw after 5.00pm Tuesday 31 March 2020 until 5.00 pm Friday 15 May 2020
- I understand that I am not entitled to any refunds on my entry fee from 5.00pm Friday 15 May 2020

7. Right to refuse application

I acknowledge that Mater Foundation reserves the right to refuse my application to register. Should my application be refused my full registration fee will be refunded to me.

8. Media and photography

I hereby grant to Mater Foundation the right, permission, and authority to use my name, image, voice, and/or likeness, without compensation, captured during the Event and its affiliated entities or contractors, and/or the media in any photographs, videotapes, CDs, DVDs, broadcast, telecast, podcast, webcast, recordings, motion pictures, commercial advertisement, promotion materials, and/or any other record of the Event for any purpose whatsoever.

I acknowledge my personal information, including photos, is collected, held and used by Mater Foundation for event coordination and administration purposes, Mater Foundation event marketing and Mater Foundation fundraising activities. 9. Communication

10. Majority Age

I affirm that I am 18 years of age (or will be at the time of the Event) or older and have read and understood what is expected of me and I agree to adhere to the direction of Mater Foundation personnel and on-road services provider at all times.

11. Acknowledgment of Understanding

THE WAIVER, RELEASE AND INDEMNITY SHALL BE INTERPRETED AND THE RIGHTS OF THE PARTIES DETERMINED UNDER THE LAW OF QUEENSLAND. THE QUEENSLAND COURTS SHALL HAVE EXCLUSIVE JURISDICTION FOR ANY DISPUTE ARISING UNDER, OR PERTAINING TO, THIS WAIVER AND RELEASE.

I have carefully read these Terms and Conditions, including the Waiver of Liability, Release and Indemnification, and fully understand its contents. I am aware that this is a waiver, release and indemnity and I sign it of my own free will. I understand that I am giving up substantial rights, including my right to sue.
