Eligibility Period:

- Starts **10:00 AM AEST on Tuesday, 30 June 2026.**
- Ends when the **\$20,000 AUD** matching cap is reached.

Donation Matching:

- All donations must be made to an official 2026 Brisbane to Gold Coast Cycle for Cancer (BNE to GC) event fundraising page.
- Registration fees are not deemed eligible donations.
- Donations must be made via the BNE to GC website. website: www.BNEtoGC.com.au
- **Match limit:** Up to \$100 per donation. Thanks to our generous anonymous corporate donor.
- **Maximum:** Five matched donations per fundraiser.
- Matched donations will appear on your fundraising page **automatically** until the cap is reached.
- The Promoter has no control over internet or mobile telecommunications, network lines, bugs, viruses or server problems, and accepts no responsibility for any problems associated with them, for whatever reason.
- Matched funds are not tax deductible and will not be shown on the donation receipt.
- Donations made before the matching period commences are not eligible to received matching.
- Donations must be made after **10:00AM** AEST on **Tuesday, 30 June 2026** up until the time the matching funds have been exhausted will be eligible for matching.
- For a donation to be considered eligible is must be made during the matching period using the official BNE to GC website, to an official fundraising page. It must be a valid donation type and made according to the matching limitations.

- The matched amount will appear on your page automatically.
